Elected member of the parliament during the general elections in 2013, she was appointed Minister in September 2013.

Minister Harito has led during 2014-2015 a deep civil service reform, toward a professional merit-based civil service in Albania, in strong collaboration with the EU Commission, as a condition in the ascension path for European Integration. This Reform is recognized actually as a best practice for the Western Balkans. Minister Harito is actually leading a large reform of the Public Services, based on digitalisation and on customer care principles.

Mrs Harito has held different management positions at Orange France between 2004-2012

She entered in 1997 as a researcher at R&D Branch of France Telecom (CNET) after a Master (DESS) degree in 1993 and a PhD degree in telecommunications at University Paris VI.

She had the Master of Science Degree in 1989 at the University of Tirana.

Besides her carrier in telecommunications in France, Mrs Harito engaged in different other activities. She published in Albanian newspapers on society and economy topics and she published in 2011 a book of conversations with Albanian Prime Ministers of the democratic transition period 1992-2011.

Mrs Harito taught courses on Information Society and on cross-cultural management at different Universities.

In 2007-2008 she participated in certain activities for the Mediterranean Union with IPEMED Institute in Paris.

In 2003 - 2004 she was the chief of staff for the Mayor of Tirana, Mr Rama, actually Prime Minister and head of the Socialist Party of Albania.
